



Using vLAB to access Athena from off campus


Copy or type the following URL into your browser: <https://eits.uga.edu/support/vlab/>

Use your UGA myID and password to log into vLAB


vLAB functions as a VPN




Click on the vLab icon


Use your phone to authenticate your login information.

Check the "Remember Me for 30 Days" box BEFORE sending notification to avoid this step each time you use vLAB.






Click on the arrow under the vLab icon to launch the program.




Be patient. It takes a few minutes for the program to load!



This is what the home screen for vLAB looks like.


It now functions like a VPN for off campus use.

Click on the Chrome (or other browser)




This is what Chrome looks like.

Type athena.uga.edu in the browser field.



As with any browser, you will be asked to authenticate your credentials .
